OUR PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Meals on Wheels

Dedicated volunteers deliver hot, nutritious noon meals right to your home; therapeutic diets can be accommodated. Meals are available up to four times a week; nominal fees apply.

Frozen Meals

A selection of delicious entrees (by *Apetito*) are also available for pick-up or delivery.

Escorted Transportation

Friendly, skilled volunteer drivers use their own vehicle to provide safe, escorted rides to medical, dental, or therapy appointments. Rides may be long distance or local. Individuals who qualify for this service are responsible for cost recovery for the volunteer driver.

Intervention and Assistance

Our client Intervention and Assistance support service provides advocacy in critical situations (risk of homelessness, abuse, isolation etc.); the client's situation is stabilized and a follow-up plan is established.

Service Arrangement and Coordination

A support service that arranges for a brokered worker or local company to provide home maintenance and repair or provide home helpers to assist with household activities. Fees vary and are arranged between the worker and client.

Friendly Visiting

A volunteer regularly visits clients in their homes, providing friendship and support, as well as checking on their health and safety. The volunteer may read, write letters, chat, play games, take a walk, or assist with an activity of daily living.

55 Alive

The 55 Alive Driver Refresher Course is designed to help older drivers refresh their knowledge and maintain their independence and their driving privileges. Courses are offered at various times during the year. A nominal cost is involved.

Living with Stroke® Series

Six week course focusing on life after a stroke

Activity Program

An afternoon of therapeutic activities and social interaction in a group setting for eligible clients, to assist them in achieving and maintaining their maximum level of function. Weekly activities may include games, lunches, crafts, education and entertainment. Transportation may be arranged. A nominal cost applies.

Footcare Clinic (Deseronto)

Professional footcare by a qualified nurse. This includes a general health assessment, the trimming of nails, scaling of corns and specific diabetic foot care. By appointment only; there is a nominal fee involved.

Telephone Reassurance and Security Check

Regular telephone contact provides friendship, support and reassurance to persons' who are housebound or isolated. Volunteers are arranged on a short or long term basis.

Social and Congregate Dining

Enjoy a hot and delicious noon dinner and a short social program at a local venue. This is a great way to renew old friendships and/or make new acquaintances. Call for dates, times, and locations of upcoming meals. Volunteer transportation may be arranged; a nominal cost applies.
