Meals on Wheels

Volunteers are required to deliver hot and frozen meals in their own vehicles to the client's home.

Hot meals are delivered Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in Belleville, and Monday, Wednesday and Friday in Deseronto at 11:00 a.m. Frozen Meals are delivered Wednesday and Thursday in Belleville.

Time Commitment: One hour per scheduled day.

Transportation

Volunteer drivers use their own vehicles to transport our clients to medical appointments. The appointments may be local or long distance and are assigned based on the volunteer's preference and availability. Volunteer drivers are reimbursed for mileage.

Time commitment: Variable depending on appointment, location and volunteer availability.

Activity Program

This program offers activities and social interaction for seniors in a group setting. Volunteers are required to provide transportation to clients, to assist with activities and to prepare and serve refreshments.

Time Commitment: One afternoon per week. (Belleville only)

Congregate Dining

Hot, nutritious dinners are provided to clients in three different communities in our service area. Volunteers are needed to provide transportation to clients, to assist with food preparation and with the set-up and clean-up of each meal, and to provide entertainment.

Administration & Fundraising
